TRINITY YOUTH CHORUS

Now in its 21st season, Trinity Youth Chorus brings together talented young people ages 5 to 18 from the five boroughs of New York City. Choristers receive individual and group training in vocal technique, music theory, sight-reading, and performance skills from Trinity's music education team.

This Grammy-nominated ensemble provides musical leadership for various worship services and offers concerts throughout the season, often performing with



Trinity's professional ensembles, including Trinity Choir, NOVUS, and Trinity Baroque Orchestra. In 2023-24, Trinity Youth Chorus was featured in two world-premiere performances: Luna Pearl Woolf's *Number Our Days* at the Perelman Performing Arts Center and Benedict Sheehan's oratorio Akathist, which was recorded alongside Trinity Choir, Artefact Ensemble, Downtown Voices, and NOVUS, and nominated for a 2025 Grammy Award for Best Choral Performance. Recent highlights include a main-stage performance for the Perelman Performing Arts Center's Refuge series, Kim André Arnesen's Tuvayhun, Carl Orff's Carmina Burana, Leonard Bernstein's Chichester Psalms, a fully staged production of Benjamin Britten's Nove's Fludde, Ellen Reid's Winter's Child at the PROTOTYPE Festival, Alberto Ginastera's Turbae ad Passionem Gregorianam and Gustav Mahler's Symphony No. 8 at Carnegie Hall, and Benjamin Britten's War Requiem with the Queens College Choral Society. Recording projects include Benedict Sheehan's Akathist, Philip Glass: Symphony No. 5, and Lisa Bielawa's My Outstretched Hand with the San Francisco Girls Chorus and The Knights.

Trinity Youth Chorus is featured in the films *Love Is Strange* and *Doubt*, as well as in Bielawa's made-for-TV opera, *Vireo*; has sung backup for Josh Groban, the Rolling Stones, and Bobby McFerrin; and has been heard on Public Radio International and CBS's *The Early Show*.

AVISTEIN, organ

Avi Stein is the organist and chorus master at Trinity Church and on the faculty of The Juilliard School, where he teaches continuo accompaniment, vocal repertoire, and chamber music. *The New York Times* described Stein as "a brilliant organ soloist" in his Carnegie Hall debut.

Stein is the artistic director of the Helicon Foundation and has directed the International Baroque Academy of Musiktheater Bavaria and the young artists' program at the Carmel Bach Festival. He has conducted a variety of ensembles, including Tafelmusik, Philharmonia Baroque, Opera Lafayette, the Portland Baroque Orchestra, the Bang on a Can All-Stars, and the Opéra Français de New York.

Stein conducted Henry Purcell's *Dido and Aeneas* at Juilliard in a production that traveled to London's Holland Park and the Royal Opera House at the Palace of Versailles. Another production at Juilliard, Luigi Rossi's *Orfeo*, was named one of the best performances of 2021 by *The New York Times*. He was featured on the 2015 Grammy Award—winning recording for Best Opera by the Boston Early Music Festival. Stein studied at Indiana University, the Eastman School of Music, and the University of Southern California, and he was a Fulbright Scholar in Toulouse, France.

PEYTON MARION,

conductor

Peyton Marion enjoys a multifaceted career as an educator, administrator, performer, and conductor. Marion has an extensive background in performing and leading liturgical music across faith traditions and musical genres. In 2019, she was the recipient of the William R. Kenan Jr. Fellowship. Her training as a classical singer and teaching artist has allowed her to lend her expertise to educational and collaborative arts programs at Lincoln Center, Carnegie Hall, Children's Museum of Manhattan, the New York Department of Education, and Opera America. As director of Music Education and Outreach at Trinity Church, she oversees a team of world-class teaching artists who reach nearly 1,000 students across New York City through music classes and workshops, and directs the Grammynominated Trinity Youth Chorus. In 2023–24, her work with the Trinity Youth Chorus included two worldpremiere performances: Luna Pearl Woolf's Number Our Days at the Perelman Performing Arts Center;



and Benedict Sheehan's oratorio *Akathist*, which was recorded alongside Trinity Choir, Artefact Ensemble, Downtown Voices, and NOVUS. She is a member of the Dramatists Guild and American Choral Directors Association and a co-owner of her family's 130-year-old farm in North Carolina.
