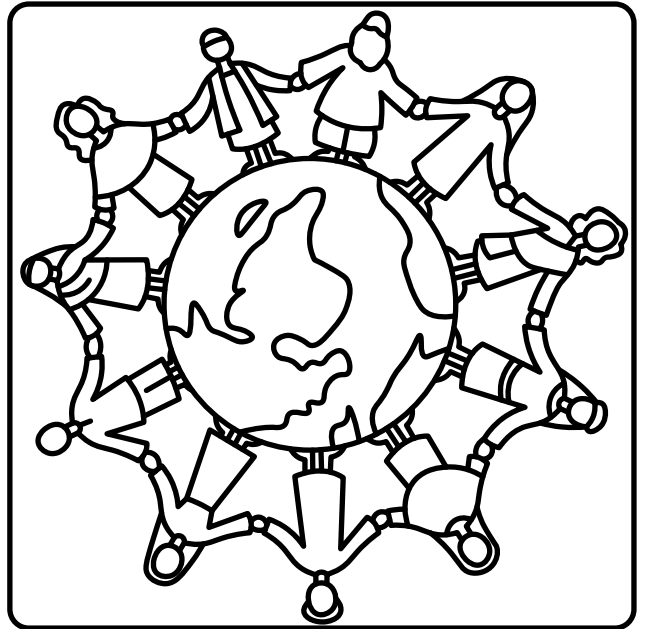


2. God continued, "I will make you well known forever, and not only will I bless you, I'll bless everyone who blesses you. Through you, every family on earth will be blessed!"
